

# **EDUCATION UNDER ATTACK**

In the Gaza Strip


As of 15 October 2023

An estimated 625,000 students and 22,564 teachers in 803 schools lost 7 learning days due to the escalation in the Gaza Strip.


164 school buildings have sustained damages, serving 166,433 students and 6,624 teachers have been affected.

An estimated 300,000 IDPs are hosted at 102 UNRWA schools and 54,453 IDPs at 51 public schools.


#### TREND (affected school buildings/cumulative)




### **SEVERITY OF DAMAGE**



### **TYPE OF SCHOOL**




## AFFECTED STUDENTS AND TEACHERS (by the damaged schools)

# **GOVERNORATES**



- The data source: Cluster partners, UNOCHA and UNRWA.
- Figures of children (>18, not only school-aged children) casualties are based on MoH as in 14th of OCT.

  The information presented in this report is based on initial data and has not been verified by the Education Cluster (EC) due to the security situation
- The EC has activated the Education Cluster Assessment Team (ECAT) and put it on standby for deployment to verify damages as soon as the situation allows Different in the number of affected schools and affected building is due to the double shifting system.
- Building of the Directorate of Education in Rafah Governorate sustained minor damage (not counted in this report).
